











Dear Body Repair Workshop Owner,

The **ISAM** bumper you purchased was primed in our latest cutting-edge painting plant making use of top quality bi-component paints.

All items are flame-hardened before priming to grant a perfect adhesion of the product to the bumper surface, and dried for about 40 minutes in the oven. All bumpers marked with the adhesive "QUALITY PRIMER" sticker on the packaging have been painted in this new plant.

TRUST our primer and do not repeat the priming process.

To paint **ISAM QUALITY PRIMER** bumpers in the shade of the body work, simply sandpaper with fine p600-p800 paper and clean with anti-silicone solvent. An important notice for all bumpers scheduled for painting, both OE and those that are equivalent to the original: after applying paint in the shade of the body work, wait at least 6 weeks (total stabilisation time of the paint) before washing the car with a pressure wash or taking it to the car wash.
